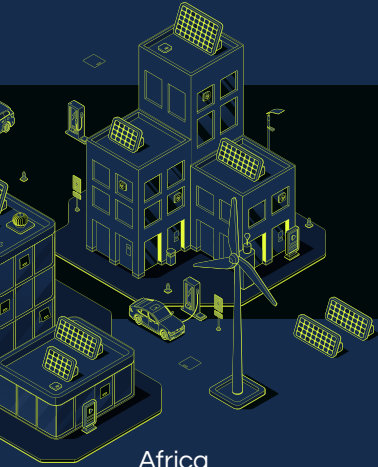

BUSINESS CLEAN ENERGY UPGRADES

C-PACE Lending funds for up to 100% of efficiency upgrades and solar for commercial buildings. Loan is paid back through a special property tax assessment.

Mortgage customers can borrow up to an additional **£15k** at 0% interest for up to 5 years.

EV PERSONAL INSTALLMENT LOAN

Loan with flexible repayment periods of **up to 60 months** and preferential rates.

SOLAR LOANS

Up to **100%** financing for solar panel at 8.24% APR, for up to 25 years and with no dealer fee.



ING

GREEN FINANCING AND CERTIFICATION

Up to **10 years** tenure business loans (minimum €25K) at a fixed and preferential interest rate. Available for certified sustainable investments (Dutch green certificate).



Banque de Tunisie

SME ENERGY LOANS

Funding of up to **85%** of sustainable energy projects. Favorable terms including up to 3 years grace period.



BBVA Colombia

SUSTAINABLE BUILDER LOANS

Consulting and financing for efficient housing (incl. on-site renewables). For certified projects, the bank finances **up to 90%** of the total costs (excl. land) at lower interest rates.



Standard Bank

BUSINESS SOLAR LOANS

Loans for power supply and storage systems. Access to partner solar suppliers through their proprietary platform.



The Commonwealth Bank

GREEN HOME LOAN

Flexible, energy-efficiency mortgage add-on for **up to \$30k** at preferential rate, with no establishment nor service fees.



OCBC

SME SUSTAINABILITY PROJECTS

Loans of up to **\$20m** for SME's sustainability projects and leasing offers for renewable energy, energy efficiency and clean transportation.
